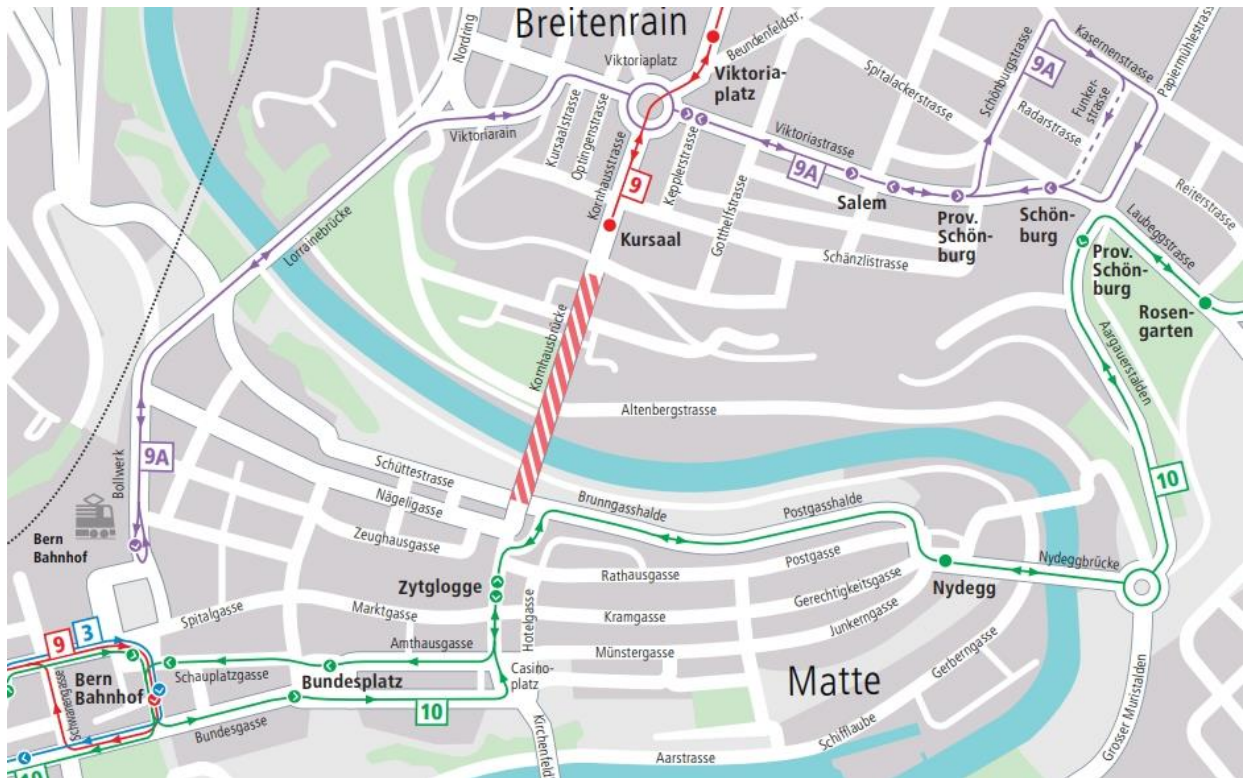


Closure of the Kornhausbrücke in Bern

The easiest way to get from the north of the city of Bern (Altenberg, Breitenrain or Wankdorf neighbourhoods) to the city centre is across Kornhausbrücke. However, the bridge will be completely closed to public transport and private motorised traffic from **17 February to 16 November 2025** (anticipated completion date) due to construction work.

Traffic will be diverted via the bridges Lorrainebrücke and Nydeggbücke. Cyclists and pedestrians will be able to cross the Kornhausbrücke at all times, but there will be varying restrictions. Daily updated information can be found [here](#).

Here's how to get to your destination by public transport:



- The trams on line 9 (red) will run on the usual route between Wabern and Bern railway station and between Wankdorf station and Kursaal.
- For line 9A (purple) between Schönburg and Bern railway station, there will be replacement buses in both directions via Viktoriarain and Lorrainebrücke.
- The buses on line 10 (green) will run on their usual route between Köniz Schliern and Bern railway station.
